**Re: Funding of equipment & training by SWIFT Medics**

SWIFT Medics recognise and thank you for your commitment to provide on-going pre-hospital emergency care in Wiltshire as a member of our charity. As part of this recognition SWIFT Medics provide some funding for the training & equipment its members use. This list includes but is not limited to:

Police response driver training

Pre-hospital emergency care course (BASICS Advanced PHEC)

Pre-hospital anaesthesia course

Equipment includes items of personal protective equipment such as flying suits & boots

Additional equipment may include modifications to your car to facilitate emergency response driving

These are provided at SWIFT Medics' expense. In return SWIFT Medics asks that you commit to a reasonable workload for ambulance response and other charity activity also to take part in a reasonable number of SWIFT Medics' regular clinical governance meetings over the three years following the funding.

If for any reason you are unable to complete this commitment for example due to moving out of Wiltshire or alternative work restrictions then we request that the funds be returned on a sliding scale as below:

|                  |   |                      |
|------------------|---|----------------------|
| Less than 1 year | - | All funding returned |
| 1-2 years        | - | 2/3 funding returned |
| 2-3 years        | - | 1/3 funding returned |

Return of individual PPE such as made to measure flight suits and boots will not generally be accepted therefore these will need to be paid for by the individual in line with the above sliding scale.

If you are not in agreement with this suggestion please do not accept funding from SWIFT Medics but contact us for an alternative plan.
